Information

Certain agrichemical products that Ravensdown supplies to customers are highly toxic and, as such, are regulated under the Health and Safety (Hazardous Substances) Regulations 2017 and the Hazardous Substances (Hazardous Property Controls) Notice 2017.

Examples of the most common of these products that Ravensdown supplies are listed in Table 1 below along with legal requirements that apply when supplying these products.

For Ravensdown to be able to lawfully supply you with these products we require written confirmation from you that:

- The substance is being supplied to a workplace;
- You have a Hazardous Substance Location Compliance Certificate if you are storing GHS Classes Acute Tox. Cat. 1, 2 or 3 (HSNO Class 6.1A, 6.1B or 6.1C) products in quantities above the threshold limits;
 - For farms (of not less than 4 ha) the threshold limits are:
Acute Tox Cat 1 (6.1A) – 100 L/kg; Acute Tox. Cat. 2 (6.1B) – 500L/kg and Acute Tox Cat 3 (6.1C) – 3,500L/kg
 - For workplaces other than farms the threshold limits are:
Acute Tox Cat 1 (6.1A) – 50L/kg; Acute Tox. Cat. 2 (6.1B) -250L/kg and Acute Tox Cat 2 (6.1C) – 1000l/kg

- Any place where the substance is to be held during transit meets emergency management and transit depot requirements under parts 5 and 13 of the HSAW Hazardous Substances Regulations 2017; and
- A “competent person” will be taking responsibility for the product (we need to know their name, position and physical address).

Note: A “competent person” is someone who has received information, instruction, and training in accordance with Part 4.5 of the HSAW Hazardous Substances Regulations 2017. This includes:

- a) Information on:
 - where the hazardous substance is present in the workplace; and
 - the availability of reference material on the hazards, safe handling, and storage of the hazardous substances found in the workplace, including (without limitation) safety data sheets.
- b) Training and instruction in:
 - the worker’s obligations under these regulations;
 - the physico-chemical and health hazards associated with the hazardous substances the worker uses at work;
 - the procedures (if applicable) for the safe use, handling, manufacture, storage, and disposal of the hazardous substances;
 - practice in the safe use of plant (including personal protective equipment) necessary to manage the hazardous substances; and
 - the actions that the worker should take in an emergency involving the hazardous substances

Note: A certified handler (for agrichemicals) is also considered a competent person in relation to products classified as Acute Tox. Cat. 1 & 2 (6.1A and 6.1B).
